

Beaver Valley Piecemakers Annual Quilt Show

26th Year Oct. 8-10, 2020

"Celebration of Quilts"

Theme – Two Color Quilts

DESCRIPTION OF THEME - Your quilt can be entered in this category if your quilt is 2 colors. There can be no tints or shades of that color. A tint is white with a color added. An example is white with red added would be pink. A shade is a color with black added. An example would be red with black added would be a dark red. The two colors in your quilt must be of the same hue, tint, or shade. The fabric doesn't have to be a solid. It can be prints as long as the print has the same hue, tint, or shade that is used in the 2 colors you choose. There can be no other small bits of color in the fabric, e.g., a teeny tiny dot, leaf, squiggle, or flower of a different color. The binding must be the same colors of your quilt. The backing fabric can be any color or print and will not be included as one of your 2 colors. The quilt can be any size.

RULES

1. All entries must be clean, complete and undamaged to qualify for judging and exhibiting. Please have your quilt free of pet hair and all pet, smoke, and chemical odors.
2. All quilt entries must be quilted and must consist of three layers, primarily fabric, held together by stitching. Do not submit tied quilts or quilts constructed in two layer techniques (Exceptions - crazy quilts and cathedral window). **Unaccepted items: table runners, bed runners, tree skirts, Christmas stocking, tote bag or any item that would be entered into an accessory category.** All decisions of the Show Committee Chairpersons (Quilt Show Chair, Co-Chair, Registration Chair, and Hanging Chair) will be final.
3. Quilts must have been completed after September 2015.
4. Due to the rod size used at the show, any quilt wider than 96" cannot be hung. All quilts **must have a 4" hanging sleeve**. The top of the sleeve on the quilt must be 90" from the bottom of the quilt. If the quilt hangs longer than 90" it will not be hung. Quilts received without a sleeve will not be accepted. Sleeves may be safety pinned on.
5. Your quilt entry must have a label. The label must include the quilt name, your name, month and year the quilt was completed. Do not sew a cover over your label. A paper will be sent to you to cover your label.
6. A non-refundable fee of **\$10 per entry, one 4 x 6 color photo per entry (front) of the quilt**, and a **business size self-addressed stamped envelope MUST accompany the entry form**. **Please label back of the photo with name of entrant, name of quilt, size of quilt (width x length), and arrow indicating top of quilt.** Entries without photo will not be accepted.
7. Entry forms must be complete and postmarked by **September 14, 2020**. Please enter early as space is limited.
8. **Entries must be available for judging and display from October 6-10, 2020**. There will be NO EARLY RELEASES.
9. If quilts are mailed to the show, it's the responsibility of the entrant to make sure sufficient packaging and postage (including insurance costs) are provided for its safe return. Call Sheila Drevna at 724-495-0825 for instruction.
10. Previously entered quilts in the Beaver Valley Piecemakers' Quilt Show will not be accepted.
11. A limit of **3 quilts per person** may be entered. If you enter 3 quilts and we have too many quilts entered for the space available, you may receive a call to pull a quilt out. If this happens you will receive your entry fee back for that quilt.
12. If you would like to sell your quilt, fill in the price under quilt description. We will give the buyer your phone number.

INSURANCE

Quilts will be insured effective upon receipt and for the duration of the show. Large quilts will be insured for \$500 and small quilts for \$100.
