

BEAVER VALLEY PIECEMAKERS BLOCK LOTTO

April 2020 block – to return at the
May 2020 meeting

GARDEN FENCE 10" (10 1/2" unfinished):



Cutting dimensions:



Yellow (Plain or w/design (fussy cut?))

Center square: 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"




MED. to Dark Gray - Outer rectangles: 4 - 2 1/2" x 3" and 4 - 2 1/2" x 5"



White: 2 - 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"; 2 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2"; and 4 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"; 2 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" and 1 1/2" x 10 1/2".

OR

Change the yellow and dark gray blocks around: Use gray in place of the yellow and the yellow in place of the gray. If you make one with colors reversed, DON'T add the sashing on the block. (the 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" and 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" cuts of white) Make one of each! Or make a couple of each! This makes a really neat-looking quilt.



Piecing the block:

1. Sew the white 4 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles to opposite side of the center square.
2. Sew 6 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles to remaining opposite sides of the center square.
3. Sew 2 of the white 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles between the 2 - 2 1/2" x 3" outer rectangles; then sew the remaining 2 white 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles between the remaining 2 1/2" x 5" dark gray outer rectangles.
4. Sew the shorter two gray pieces of step 3 to opposite sides of the center pieced square.
5. Sew the remaining gray rectangles to the opposite sides of the center pieced square.
6. Add the 1 1/2" sashing around the entire block. Easy! Easy!

As stated in the newsletter, I have not had a chance to test this pattern to make sure I have all the measurements and instructions accurate. Please double-check as you go, to make sure everything is working out. Once I get a chance to make this block, I'll remove this text block from the instructions, so you'll know everything is accurate.
